

In addition to her position as director of Bereavement Support and Services at GAMC, she has a private practice counseling the bereaved, speaks internationally on current issues pertaining to death, dying, and bereavement, and is a published author and a bereavement educator.

In 2001, Alice co-founded the Center for Grief and Loss for Children. She takes an active role in several professional organizations, including the Association of Death Education and Counseling, the American Association of Suicidology, National Hospice Organization, International Critical Incident Stress Foundation, Inc., the American Association of Christian Counselors and the Association of Professional Chaplains. She is a member of the palliative care team and the Spiritual Life Council at GAMC.
